

Cycle route near Marielyst 20 km

- Start the tour from Marielyst Town Square and ride along Marielyst Strandvej towards Væggerløse.
- In front of the Hotel Nørrevang you can see a memorial stone and a water level pillar for the flood in 1872.
- After the roundabout, further out to the left you will find Lyns Fishing Put & Take Lake.
- Turn right onto Stouby Tværvej and past Marielyst Sports Cars, an automobile museum with an extensive collection of sports cars from 1913 to 1970.
- At Stoubyvej turn left towards Stouby Mill and Glassworks. There is a shop and exhibition in the mill.
- Further ahead along Stoubyvej to Væggerløse, turn left at the small roundabout, in through the village, to the right just before the village pond and past the Church. There is a splendid view from Væggerløse Church.
- Further along Gedser Landevej, past Marielyst Strandvej and to the right along Radbjergvej, past Radbjerg Ceramics, which houses a workshop and exhibition centre.
- On to the canal and out onto Gedser Landevej, where you can see the old Bøtø Nor Pumping station.
- In Marrebæk we come past the idyllic village pond, which is an excellent place to enjoy a thermos of coffee.
- Continue along Godthåbs Allé.
- Further ahead we pass Marielyst Go-cart & Paintball Centre, which boasts a 525 m long track and a 11,000 m² paintball course.
- Turn left onto Bøtø Ringvej and then right onto Bøtø Møllevej and follow the road out towards the beach.
- Just after we have ridden onto Bøtøvej, the Strand Church stands on the right and soon after we are back at Marielyst Town Square.
